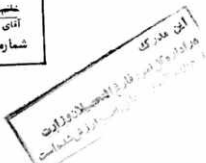
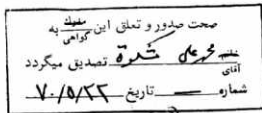
During Part I of the course (October 1981 - May 1984) you followed lectures and were successful in examinations in the following subjects:
